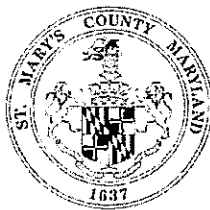




Dear Chairman Rey:






