The Commissioners of St. Mary's County **OPPOSE** House Bill 655 Local Government – County Commissioner Elections – District Voting which was heard on February 9, 2021 in the Ways and Means Committee and received a favorable with amendments report and was heard today on the House Floor.

However, the Commissioners of St. Mary's County would support an amendment that would allow this bill, upon passage, to go to a voter referendum for the people of St. Mary's County to decide and vote on in the 2022 election:

• HB 655 - County Commissioner Elections – District Voting (plurality voting).

In addition, the Commissioners of St. Mary's County also requests that a second referendum question be put to the voters of St. Mary's County in the 2022 election:

• Eliminating election districts so that the elections are held at large.

We OPPOSE HB 655 and do not believe this legislation would benefit the citizens of St. Mary's County. Rather, we request amendment to this bill that puts the contents of this bill and the elimination of election districts to referendum for the voters of St. Mary's County to decide.
