RE: HB 862 – Letter of Support

Section 27-11A of Article 19 – Public Laws of St. Mary's County Section 113-6A of Article 19 – Public Laws of St. Mary's County

Dear Chairman McIntosh and Members of the Appropriations Committee:

The Metropolitan Commission (MetCom) supports the above referenced House Bill, scheduled for hearing at 1:30 p.m. on February 24, 2021. As a follow-up to our prior support letter submitted on November 17, 2020, HB 862 proposes to decouple the Metropolitan Commission (MetCom) debt from the Commissioners of St. Mary's County (CSMC) debt. In lieu of the current combined total sum of 2.15 % of the assessable real property in the County, the Bill as drafted suggests that the combined debt should be raised to 3.15% and proportionally distributed between both the CSMC and the Metropolitan Commission and that the outdated 25% provision in Section 113-6A also be updated accordingly.

We greatly appreciate the introduction of this Bill, which is a result of excellent coordination between the Commissioners of St. Mary's County, our Board, and the local Delegation. As the Delegation is aware, the combined indebtedness cap in the current codified legislation has been a concern for the MetCom since it was originally introduced into Section 27-11A. As such, we fully support the de-coupling concept as proposed under this Bill.

We believe that HB 862 will benefit the citizens of St. Mary's County and will provide both the Metropolitan Commission and CSMC with some additional flexibility into the foreseeable future.
