Assessments - Real Property

The State Department of Assessments and Taxation determines the taxable assessment of your real property. It is important that you verify assessment notices received from the State Department of Assessments and Taxation for accuracy. Property assessments you do not agree with may be [appealed](#).

I appealed my assessment, but my taxes are due, what should I do?

Obligation to pay taxes is not stayed or suspended pending an appeal from the assessment. Please remit payment.

What if I have paid my taxes and then the assessment is lowered? How do I get a refund?

On the final determination of an appeal, money paid by a taxpayer that exceeds the amount properly chargeable under the determination shall be refunded through the County Treasurer's Office if the amount exceeds \$100.00.

St. Mary's County Refund Policy

Refunds for an account that equal \$100.00 or less will be applied to the account's balance for the following tax year.
