A Community That Shares (ACTS)

Volunteers receive, repair, or disperse free medical equipment in the ACTS' warehouse. Office volunteers work a four hour shift answering phone calls and arranging equipment pick-up. ACTS warehouse is located in the 7th district of St. Mary's County in Avenue.

Volunteers for Veterans

Volunteers are needed to provide friendly visitation to Veterans residing at the Charlotte Hall Veterans Home. Volunteers provide a friendly face and listening ear to cheer the day of these veterans. Volunteers visit, talk, listen, and read with a Veteran as well as escort them to special activities. There is also help needed in the gift shop. Technology support volunteers assist Veterans with computers, tablets, and cell phones.

Patuxent Habitat for Humanity

Volunteers are needed to provide customer assistance within the ReStore in Lexington Park. Volunteers receive, price, and tag items to sell in the ReStore. Many other volunteer opportunities are available such as fundraising, public relations, computer data entry, home renovations, and more!
