What is it?

Responsible Alcohol Service Training (R.A.S.T.) is a program designed to discuss responsible alcohol policies, review issues identified by enforcement agencies and have an opportunity to meet for networking among peers

What it is NOT?

R.A.S.T. does not fulfill the State mandated alcohol awareness training certification requirement

Who should attend?

Licensees are mandated by law to attend R.A.S.T. However, the program is designed to educate St. Mary's County servers, sellers, management, and owners on alcohol beverage regulatory compliance – so anyone serving or selling alcohol will benefit from the training

When?

Classes are being scheduled based on business type. Please contact the office to see what dates and times are available for your business.
