

SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFIERS



A SCHOLARSHIP FORM
MUST BE COMPLETED AND
INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- Current St. Mary's County residents who are students between the ages of 5-20 who also.
- Receive Free or Reduced lunch from St. Mary's County Public Schools (SMCPS IEP report for TR camp), and
- Those students who do not receive Purchase of Care for summer programs. *If you receive assistance for summer camp programs through the DSS other County or State funding, you do not qualify to apply for this scholarship. -or
- St. Mary's County residents who are 18 years or older and have a MD Independence Card.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

St. Mary's County Recreation & Parks is pleased to provide an opportunity for participants to apply for a scholarship. Scholarships are made available through the generous contributions of several local civic organizations, net proceeds from the department's Scholarship Fund Golf Tournament and other special events throughout the year.

The scholarship's offered provide qualified individual applicants the opportunity to participate in one recreation activity, at a 50% prorated amount off the registration fee, each year.

TO APPLY

- 1. Submit a completed Scholarship Application & Program Registration.
- 2. Provide proof of eligibility and attach to Scholarship Application. (Proof of eligibility includes Free or Reduced Lunch approval form, proof of enrollment at a Community Eligibility Provision school or Independence Card for adults).
- 3. Currently have residence in St. Mary's County. Only St. Mary's County residents will be considered for scholarship.
- 4. Payment-50% of program registration fee due with completed application
